

Why is higher biodiversity good for farmers?

1. Habitats with more species better adapt to environmental changes
→ stable yields during dry period
2. Higher number of bees and bumblebees-better polination
→ higher yields
3. Higher number of beneficial insects that reduce pests
→ reduction of yield loses
4. More diverse flora and fauna in soil bring revitalized, more active soil life
→ reduction of soil pests
